Pro Musica is pleased to present the 2010-2011 new season of its three prestigious series : the Emerald, the Topaz and the Sapphire series : twelve splendid concerts, all taking place inside of the Place des Arts complex : easily accessible underground parking and access by metro or bus – and its elegantly re-designed hall .

Piano will have the place of honour in our Emerald Series with four top-ranking piano recitals. Marc-André Hamelin, whose success in our 60th Jubilee events still remains vivid in our memory, will start the ball rolling. Breathtaking also are the other three recitalists: from Ukraine, Valentina Lisitsa ; from Russia, Yevgeny Sudbin (third presentation) and Maneli Pirzadeh, Canadian virtuoso of Iranian extraction.

Impressive string quartets add a beautiful touch to the series : from the Czech Republic and critically acclaimed for more than 30 years, the Pražák Quartet and two young newcomers already renowned : the Jerusalem Quartet from Israel and the Kuss Quartet from Germany. And to complete the picture: a cello and piano duo featuring two imposing partners: Gautier Capuçon from France and Gabriela Montero from Venezuela and the United-States.

As for our Sunday afternoon concerts, the Topaz Series, you will find in the limelight young but impeccable artists: a highly accomplished foursome, the Alcan String Quartet, a very refined harpist, Valérie Milot, and the First Prize in the Montreal International Piano Competition (JMC) in 2004, Ukrainian pianist Serhiy Salov.

And ending on another high note, a magnificent Sapphire Concert performed by one of the most prestigious American pianists. His name will be revealed at the end of October. In total, internationally acclaimed performers and high quality programs, substantial and varied. Moreover, the price for our series has remained the same for three years. There's no question: you don't want to miss out on such an opportunity!

Looking forward to meeting you at our 2010-2011 season concerts and to listening to "the most genuine and the most nuanced music...the one that goes straight from the stage to your heart!"
